As a parent or fan of the SBMC Soccer Club, you agree to the following conduct criteria at all soccer events:

- 1. You agree to remember young players are involved in soccer for their enjoyment.
- 2. You agree to be an encourager for all the children at all soccer events.
- 3. You agree to always have good sportsmanship.
- 4. You agree to applaud good play on both sides.
- 5. You agree to only make positive words of encouragement to all players including your own.
- 6. You agree to not coach from the sidelines because it only confuses players.
- 7. You agree to help your child learn about responsibility through playing soccer.
- 8. You agree to not place emphasis on "winning at all costs."
- 9. You agree that profane language or harassment of referees, coaches, or players has no place at any youth sports event.
- 10. You agree to always be on your best behavior.
- 11. You agree to abide by the rules of the club and your team.
- 12. You agree that if you do not respect authority, your child will learn to not respect authority.
- 13. You agree to always be classy.
- 14. You agree to follow all rules of the game and all rules of the venue.
- 15. You agree to use the 48-hour rule after all events.
- 16. You agree to no soccer talk in car rides home from games.
- 17. You agree to be classy and be a great representative of our SBMC Soccer Club at all times.
- 18. You understand that Team Volunteer Staff, Team Trainers, and The SBMC Soccer Club Staff can only address your concerns if they know about them.
